#### *The Scene*

Rising above a construction-laden portion of Lincoln Boulevard, the exterior of this 12-story hotel resembles a modern downtown loft. Inside, dark hallways lead to brightly lit, minimally decorated suites with Percale Italian linens, Lather bath products, flat screens and a view of the city.

#### *The Details*

Tricked-out takes on meeting rooms, free WiFi and complimentary espresso at check-in bring in the cutting-edge business set while the outdoor pool's Hopscotch bar and lobby DJ give locals a place to play. The two workout rooms (one cardio and one weight training) are perfect for counteracting the hotel's Bistrotek restaurant—which dishes out contemporary comfort food—as well as the fourth floor's Bazaar, an entire room dedicated to vending machines. Luckily, they're not all stocked with candy and soda. Parents, (and those who don't want to become them) should note that there's an 18-and-older machine.
